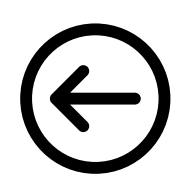

- OneSearch is the tool for searching paper and electronic bibliographic resources at the libraries of the University of Pisa. Our resources include books in the libraries, paper journals, electronic journals, scientific articles, institutional archives for research and for theses, integrated databases of digital resources, also in image format.
- OneSearch is a cooperation among the Tuscan universities belonging to SBART (Library Systems of Tuscan universities ) and searching for books is also extended to all SBART.
- Authentication gives you access to reserved services i. e. Inter Library Services, your personal account with loans, reservations, bookmarks.
- E-books and other online subscribed resources are available upon connection via a University IP address, including VPN.





# ACCESSING your account

*Authentication gives you access to reserved services.*

- Enter your institutional username and password and you will have access to your personal account.






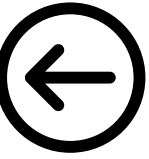
# Searching for BOOKS

- Enter some words in the search box and select Only the books from the drop-down menu.

Click on the magnifying glass.

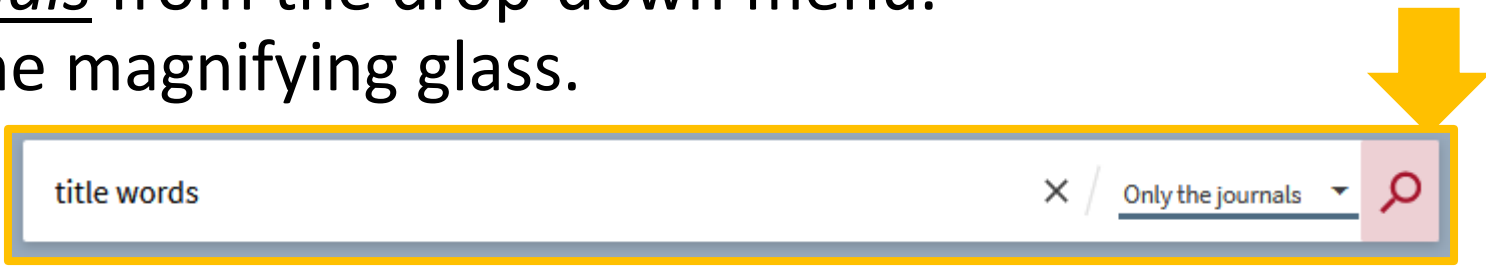


- From the results choose them desired and go on Available. Check 'location'? or on Online access if the resource is online.
- Use the filters  on the right in case of many results.

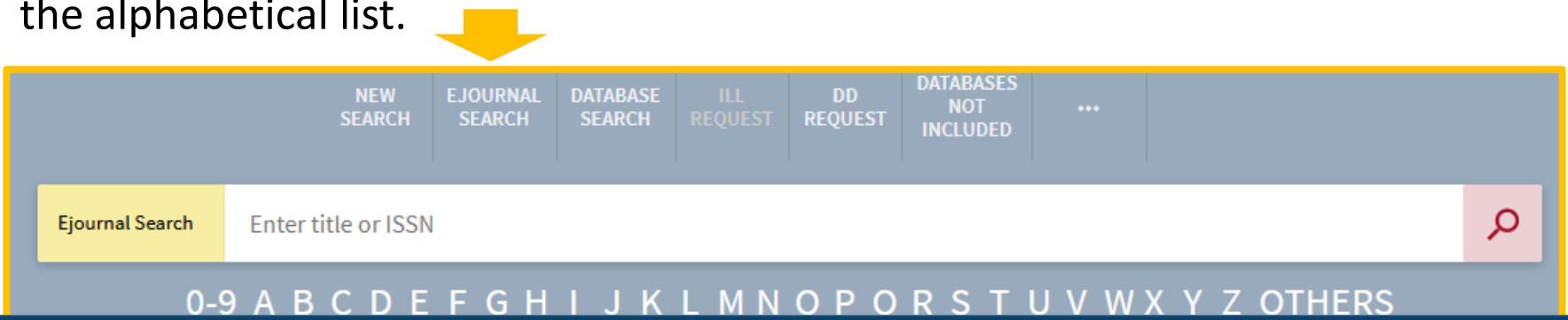


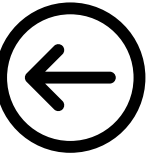
# Searching for JOURNALS

- Enter words of the title of the journal in the search box and select Only journals from the drop-down menu. Click on the magnifying glass.



From the menu on the top you can search for an electronic journal by title or ISSN, otherwise by browsing the alphabetical list.





# Searching for ARTICLES and more ...

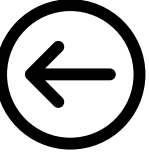
*OneSearch retrieves references from many archives, not only open access, included some subscribed integrated databases and the institutional archives for research and for the theses .*

- Enter some keywords in the search box. Click on the magnifying glass.



With Expand My Results, on the right, you obtain also references without full-text available. Make sure your connection is by an institutional IP address to access the full-text of the subscribed resources.

Try with less words or other words if your search didn't give the desired results.



# Searching for DATABASES

*to get information about subscribed databases and how to access them.*

- Menu on the top, click on Database search, then fill up the search box with the database name, or browse alphabetically, or by category.





# RENEW a loan, RESERVE a book

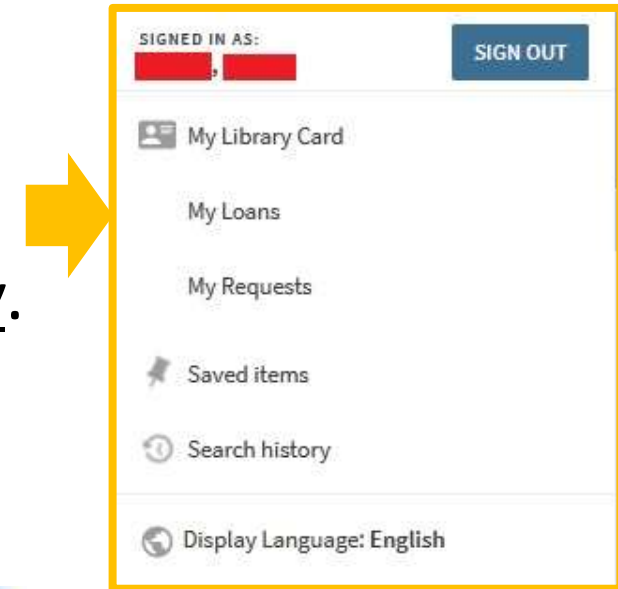
Firstly access your account :

- To renew a loan go to [My Loans](#), click on [Renew](#).

Check the new due date to be sure that the loan is renewed. If the book is requested by another user the link [Renew](#) is not more active.

- To reserve a book search it, then click on  .

The link [Request](#) is active only if there aren't any other items available on the shelves. An e-mail will notify you when you can borrow the book from the library.







# Advanced search and wildcards

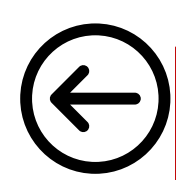
*suggested, for example, if only the first part of a word is known.*

The Advanced search allows to specify

- the field which the terms entered belong to,
- the relationships Contains, Is (exact phrase) , Start with,
- publication date,
- type of document (included images, audiovisuals, maps, scores).

## Wildcards

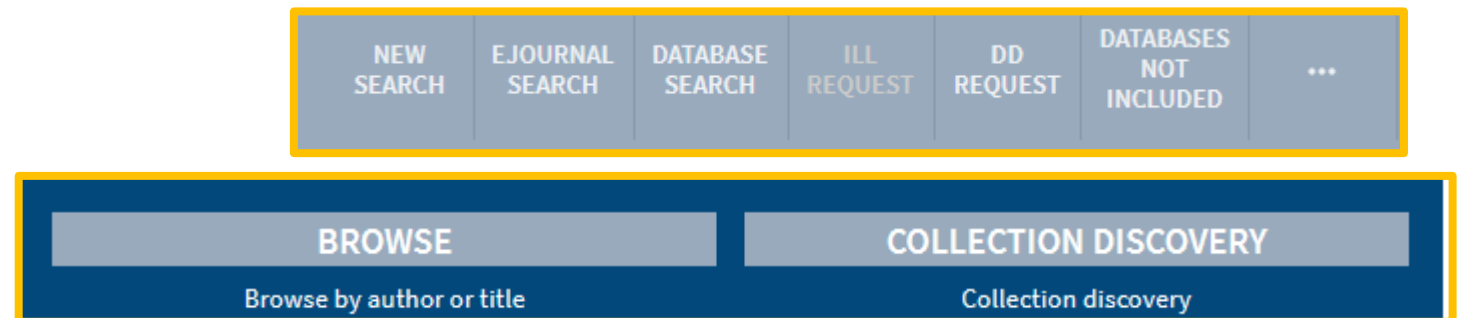
- \* mask the ending part of a word: int\* stands for international, etc ...
- ? mask a character: wom?n stands for woman, women



# Browsing, digital collections

From the dots it appears also

- Browse, that allows you browsing by author or title.
- Collection discovery for the Collections of works that are digitalized by the Library System of the University of Pisa.
